INTRO QUESTIONS:

- What encouraged or challenged you from the sermon and/or the daily exercises this week?
- Who is the most humble person you know? How do you think they got that way?
- How do you think humility is perceived in our world of unrestrained self-promotion?

KEY PASSAGES:

- **2 Corinthians 4:5** - How well do you think Paul's claims in this passage describe you? Would other people in your life affirm your assessment?
- **Galatians 5:13-14** - Why do you think it can be so difficult to use our freedom for humble service?
- **Philippians 2:3-11** - What is one practical thing you could do this week to better live out this passage?

GROUP DISCUSSION:

- Can you imagine humbly serving someone you knew would betray you like Jesus did? What does that tell you about Jesus' willingness to serve you?
- On a scale of 1-10, how do you think the person who knows you best would rate your humility? Why?
- What insecurities do you think might be behind your own struggles with humility?
- Who is someone in your life you need to do a better job of humbly serving? What could you do this week to serve them better?

WEEKLY APPLICATION:

- On page 275, we were challenged to do one act of humble service for someone we live with AND to not say anything about what we did. With that in mind, simply raise your hand if you did the challenge.
